LATIN AMERICA & CARIBBEAN

Open data is used across all sectors in Latin America and the Caribbean.* Nonprofits and developer groups account for a large proportion of the organizations that use open data. The majority are SMEs.

* Regions and country income levels reflect the World Bank geographic regions and income-level classifications.

SUMMARY

Nonprofits and media organizations in [Latin America and the Caribbean](#) use open data for research, journalism and advocacy. Many companies are also using this resource to provide IT and geospatial, business, research and consulting services across the region. Many focus on using open data in ways that provide social benefits as well, such as improving financial access and inclusion. Government operations, demographic and social, geospatial, business and economic data are the most used types of open data.


